As reported in previous editions, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund (VVMF) has undertaken a project to gather pictures of everyone whose name is memorialized on the wall in an effort to preserve their legacy for generations to come. You can see the collection at http://www.vvmf.org/Wall-of-Faces/ The PA Department of Veterans Affairs (DMVA) is trying to help get photos of everyone who died from Pennsylvania. When we first reported on this story last March, there were 11 veterans whose photos had not been identified. Today, that number is down to ONE – MSgt Matthew Harris, Jr. If you served with MSgt Harris or know him from the neighborhood and have a photo let us know and we'll help put you in touch with the VVMF. You can also help by spreading the word to your friends, family and coworkers. Let's do our part to help honor on of our own!

Wall of Faces - Missing Photo

MSgt. Matthew Harris, Jr. (DOB 4/1/1931) The career of Air Force non-commissioned officer, a 1948 graduate of Overbrook High School had served in Japan and Morocco, among other places before being assigned to the 33rd Air Force Dispensary in Vietnam in February 1965. The 34-year-old medical service technician died in Saigon on May 28, 1965. He was survived by a wife and a son.
